

GarageBand Familiarity Quiz Questions

- Click on the pan pot for track 3.
- Click on the Record button in the picture.
- Click on any audio loop region.
- Click on the button that brings up the track editor window.
- Click on the button that arms track 3 for recording.
- Click on Garageband's timeline.
- Click on the timeline scrollbar.
- Click the button that creates a new track in the timeline.
- Click on the main volume clipping indicators.
- Click on the mute button in track 3.
- Click on the button that returns the playhead to the beginning of your song.
- Click on the button that rewinds the playhead measure by measure.
- Click on the button that opens or closes the track info window.
- Click on the level meters for track 3.
- Click on the button that opens or closes the volume and pan automation display for track 3.
- Click on the button that fast forwards the timeline measure by measure.
- Click on any MIDI loop shown in the loop browser.
- Click on the button that pops up the timeline resolution menu.
- Click on the solo button for track 3.
- Click on any track's header.
- Click on the button that will cause any selected timeline section to cycle over and over.
- Click on any MIDI loop region shown in the timeline.
- Click on the button that brings up the loop browser.
- Click on the beat ruler that shows where the playhead is in the timeline.
- Click on any track's mixer area.
- Click on the loop browser's keyword search buttons
- Click on the button that allows you to listen to an audio track as you record it.
- Click on the volume automation display for the beats track.
- Click on the button that converts track 3 to a straight audio recording.
- Click on the Play button.
- Click on the third iteration of an audio loop in the timeline.
- Click on the zoom slider that magnifies or demagnifies the timeline display.
- Click on the button that opens or closes the effects details panel (to add audio effects, etc.)
- Click on the area that would open the vocal transformer.
- Click on the area that would open the speech enhancer.
- Click on the Playhead. (It indicates where you are in your song.)
- Click on the region recorded from an outside source.
- Click on any audio loop shown in the browser.
